Rules & Scoring

- 1.** The Signer cannot speak or write the words - British Sign Language only. No singing, either!
- 2.** Each time a teammate guesses the correct word, the Signer's team scores a point.
- 3.** Signers can lose points in two ways: passing on a card or breaking rule number 1.

How to Play

- 1.** Divide pupils up into an even amount of teams.
- 2.** Each team member takes a turn at being the "Signer".
- 3.** The Signer will attempt to get his or her teammates to guess the word on their card by spelling it out using British Sign Language.
- 4.** Once the team correctly guesses the word, the Signer will move on to the next card - until the time runs out (1 minute).
- 5.** When time runs out, play will pass to the next team.
- 6.** When all the players in each team have had one turn as the Signer, the points are totaled up. The team with the most points wins the game.
